

- This manual is specific to the car indicated on the cover page, for which it is designed.
 Installation procedures vary depending on the type of car. Please verify that the Akrapovič exhaust system and this installation manual correspond to the type of your car.
- The exhaust system can get extremely hot during and after it is used. Make sure not to touch
 the exhaust system until it is completely cool. Allow the exhaust and engine to cool down
 before beginning installation.
- Make sure the car is securely positioned to prevent damage to yourself ond other, or the car.
- Please check the parts you recieved against the parts list available on our website (please
 use the QR code on the front page or look for "schematic view" in the respective product
 page on www.akrapovic.com). Make sure that you have all the parts necessary for the
 installation of your new Akrapovič exhaust system. If any of the parts is missing, please
 do not proceed with uninstalling your stock exhaust system/installing the Akrapovič exhaust
 system and contact the retailer where you purchased the Akrapovič exhaust system.
- Every exhaust system muffler has its unique serial number, which identifies the authenticity
 of the product. You can find the serial number on the muffler's sleeve. Please refer to the
 picture 1 below. Please verify that your exhaust system is an original Akrapovič product. If
 you have any doubts, please contact the reseller where you purchased the exhaust system
 or Akrapovič partners. This manual, any certificates and Akrapovič warranty apply to original
 products only.

USE BOLT SEALANT

Apply 3 to 4 small drops of bolt sealant onto the cleaned and degreased threads before tightening the bolts.

WARNING! Avoid contact with skin, eyes and mucous membranes. Do not inhale fumes. Keep out of reach of children.



USE ANTI-SEIZE LEAD-FREE COPPER PASTE (black tube)


Provides trouble-free and long-lasting protection against seizing, corrosion and rusting of bolts, threaded ends, nuts, joints, etc. Also protects against vibration, wear and impact. WARNING! Avoid eye contact. Keep out of reach of children.



USE ANTI-SEIZING GREASE (white tube)

Prevents seizing, corrosion and excessive wear between the titanium components of your exhaust system. WARNING! Avoid eye contact. Keep out of reach of children.

IMPORTANT: The car should be in the off position throughout the dismounting and installation process, as well as any other work done on the exhaust system!

In case your Akrapovič exhaust system may not be used on certain roads or under certain conditions, please keep the stock or other exhaust system that you can use in such circumstances legally.



REMOVAL OF STOCK EXHAUST SYSTEM:

Put the vehicle onto a car lift.

- ! CAUTION: make sure, that car lifting is safely and correctly done or you risk vehicle damage, injury or even death!
- Carefully undo the marked trim panels and unscrew tail light bolts on both sides of the vehicle (Figure 1, 2).



MPORTANT: be careful not to damage the trim panels, tail lights or any other part of the vehicle during this procedure!




- 2. Carefully remove both tail lights, disconnect the connectors and remove both tail lights off the vehicle (Figure 3).
 - IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage the tail lights, connectors or any other part of the vehicle during this procedure!



- 3. Unscrew the marked bolts on both sides of the vehicle and carefully **partially** remove the rear bumper (**Figure 4, 5, 6**).
 - ! IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage or scratch any part of the vehicle during this procedure!









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- 4. Disconnect the bumper's electrical connector and carefully remove the rear bumper off the vehicle (Figure 7).
 - IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage the connector or any other part of the vehicle during this procedure!



- 5. Unscrew the marked nuts and bolts on both sides of the vehicle and carefully remove the side mufflers' heat shields (Figure 8, 9).
 - IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage the heat shields or any other part of the vehicle during this procedure!






- 6. Unscrew the marked bolts on both sides of the vehicle and carefully remove the central muffler's heat shield (Figure 10).
 - IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage the heat shield or any other part of the vehicle during this procedure!




- Loosen the clamp and remove the tail pipes, loosen the double clamp and slide it out off the
 joint and unscrew the three marked nuts (Figure 11). Repeat the procedure on both sides of
 the vehicle.
 - IMPORTANT: be careful not to damage any part of the vehicle during this procedure!




- 8. Unscrew the marked nuts on both sides of the vehicle and carefully remove the side mufflers off the vehicle (Figure 12).
 - ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself, or damage any part of the vehicle during this procedure!
 - ! CAUTION: support the side mufflers during this procedure or you could injure yourself or damage the vehicle!



- 9. Carefully pull the vacuum hoses off the vacuum actuators (Figure 13).
 - ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself, or damage any part of the vehicle during this procedure!



- 10. Loosen the header tubes' flange bolts on both sides of the engine (Figure 14).
- ! IMPORTANT: loosen the bolts only, do not fully unscrew them!




- 11. Unscrew the central muffler's clamps and carefully remove the muffler off the vehicle (Figure 15).
 - ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself, or damage any part of the vehicle during this procedure!

CAUTION: support the muffler during this procedure or you could injure yourself or damage the vehicle!




INSTALLATION OF THE AKRAPOVIČ EXHAUST SYSTEM:

- 1. **For vehicles with original sports exhaust system only:** assemble the heat protection onto the rubber vacuum tubes using tape clamps; bind the other ends of the rubber tubes, using plastic Y distributor and clamps, as shown **(Figure 16).**
- IMPORTANT: do not tighten the tape clamps yet!



- 2. **For vehicles with non-sports original exhaust system only:** assemble the heat protection onto the rubber vacuum tubes using tape clamps; bind the other ends of the rubber tubes with pvc vacuum tubes, as shown **(Figure 17).**
 - IMPORTANT: do not tighten the tape clamps yet!




- 3. **For vehicles with non-sports original exhaust system only:** assemble the Akrapovič pvc vacuum tubes into the original rubber vacuum outlets and secure the connections, using tape clamps from Akrapovič installation kit **(Figure 18, 19).**
 - IMPORTANT: do not overtighten the tape clamps!





- For vehicles with non-sports original exhaust system only: direct and secure the Akrapovič vacuum tubes, exactly as shown (Figure 20, 21).
 - ! IMPORTANT: direct the vacuum tubes in such a way, that they don't touch any hot or moving parts!

IMPORTANT: make sure, that vacuum tubes are not bent or obstruct in any way!





- 5. Correctly orient the central muffler's clamps and carefully slide them onto the muffler (Figure 22).
 - IMPORTANT: use anti-seize copper paste on clamps' bolt and nut threads!
 - IMPORTANT: do not screw the bolts into the clamps yet!





- 6. Hang the central muffler onto the bracket, as shown (Figure 23, 24).
 - IMPORTANT: use new exhaust gaskets in Akrapovič muffler's inlet pipes stock headers joints!
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself, or damage any part of the vehicle during this procedure!






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
- 7. Slide the clamps over the muffler's bracket, align the muffler in respect to the vehicle chassis and tighten the clamps to the specified torque (Figure 25).
 - IMPORTANT: make sure to position the clamps over the original bracket correctly!




- 8. Hang both side mufflers onto the brackets and flanges; hand tighten the stock nuts (Figure 26).
 - ! IMPORTANT: do not fully tighten the side mufflers' brackets and flange nuts yet!




- Insert the buffers correctly (check the correct orientation of the marks!), attach and orient
 the clamps exactly as shown and tighten the clamps to the specified torque (Figure 27, 28).
- ! IMPORTANT: use anti-seize copper paste on clamps' bolt and nut threads!





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
- 10. Tighten the central muffler's flanges and side mufflers brackets on both sides of the vehicle (Figure 29, 30).
 - IMPORTANT: use anti-seize copper paste on all nut threads!







- 11. Retighten the header tubes' flange bolts on both sides of the engine (Figure 31).
- ! IMPORTANT: tighten the stock bolts to a specified torque using criss-cross pattern in three steps!



- 12. For vehicles with sports original exhaust system only: redirect the stock vacuum outlet tube as shown and bind it with the Akrapovič vacuum tubes; secure the connection using clamps from Akrapovič installation kit (Figure 32).
 - IMPORTANT: direct the stock vacuum tube in such a way, that it doesn't touch any hot or moving parts!

IMPORTANT: make sure, that stock vacuum tube is not bent or obstruct in any way!




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
- 13. Connect the vacuum tubes to the vacuum actuators and tighten the tape clamps (Figure 33).
- ! IMPORTANT: do not overtighten the tape clamps!



- 14. Reassemble the central muffler's heat shield; direct the vacuum tubes between the two heat shields, as shown (Figure 34, 35).
 - IMPORTANT: make sure, that only heat protected part of the vacuum tubes extends into the inner side of the muffler's heat shield!



IMPORTANT: make sure, that the vacuum tubes are not bent or obstruct in any way!



- 15. Replace all dismounted stock parts (heat shields, bumper, tail lights) in the reverse order from the order in which they were removed. Check vehicle manufacturer manual for tightening torques.
- ! IMPORTANT: make sure, that you connect all disconnected electrical connectors!
- 16. Assemble the clamps and spherical rings onto the tail pipes, as shown (Figure 36).
- IMPORTANT: use anti-seize copper paste on all clamp bolt threads!




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- 17. Slide the tail-pipes onto the muffler outlets. Rotate and center them in respect to rear bumper and according to your personal taste (Figure 37).
 - IMPORTANT: make sure, not to damage tail pipes, bumper or any part of the vehicle during this procedure!



18. Tighten tail pipe clamps to the specified torque on both sides of the vehicle (Figure 38).



FINAL INSTALLATION:

- ! IMPORTANT: reinstall the dismounted or partially removed stock parts (wheel arches, bumper etc.); check vehicle manufacturer manual for tightening torques.
- ! IMPORTANT: make sure all the nuts and bolts are sufficiently tightened. In case the exhaust system touches the cowling or other parts, repeat the adjustment of the exhaust system or contact your authorized dealer.
- ! IMPORTANT: clean all exhaust components before the first start of the engine or the stains will burn onto the surfaces!

MAINTENANCE OF THE AKRAPOVIČ EXHAUST SYSTEM:

- Clean the titanium exhaust components with a multi-purpose spray lubricant (WD-40[®] or equivalent)*, carbon fiber exhaust components with soft and dry cloth and stainless steel components with soft cloth sprayed with contact cleaner, then wipe with soft and dry cloth. A change in the color of the exhaust system is normal due to high temperatures.
- Periodically make sure all the bolts and springs are sufficiently tight.
 *WD-40[®] is a trademark of the WD-40 Company.
- NSTALLATION TIP: IT IS NORMAL FOR WHITE SMOKE TO COME OUT OF THE MUFFLER AT FIRST OPERATION.
- ! CAUTION: DO NOT STAND BEHIND THE MUFFLER AT ANY TIME.
- ! CAUTION: DO NOT USE AUTOMOTIVE WHEEL CLEANERS OR ANY CLEANING PRODUCTS WHICH CONTAIN ACIDIC ADDITIVES TO CLEAN THE AKRAPOVIČ EXHAUST SYSTEMS.

WARNING: THE EXHAUST SYSTEM CAN BE EXTREMELY HOT. ALLOW THE EXHAUST AND ENGINE TO COOL DOWN BEFORE BEGINNING INSTALLATION OR ANY OTHER WORK ON THE EXHAUST SYSTEM. THIS MANUAL IS SPECIFIC TO THE PORSCHE 911 CARRERA S. THERE MAY BE SOME DIFFERENCES IN INSTALLATION PROCEDURES FOR OTHER MODELS.

TROUBLESHOOTING:

Exhaust gas leaks out of the muffler/pipe clamp connections	loosened clamp	tighten the clamp to specified torque
	connection is not completely joined	tap the connection into place and tighten the clamp to specified torque
Valves are not moving	No supply	Check green LED on the Control Kit. If the LED is off:
	Error detected	Check green LED on the Control Kit. If the LED is blinking fast:





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
